ASCLEPIA PERENNIS



IN FLORIDA WE HAVE MIGRATING MONARCH BUTTERFLIES AND ALSO LOCAL POPULATIONS. DWINDLING MONARCH POPULATIONS CAN BE LINKED TO LOSS OF HABITAT AND THE LACK OF NATIVE MILKWEED. EVEN IF WE WOULD LIKE TO PLANT NATIVE MILKWEED IT IS HARD TO FIND.

MORINGA GARDEN CIRCLE IS CONTRACT GROWING NATIVE MILKWEED. SPECIFICALLY "ASCHEPIA PERENNIS". WE WILL BE TAKING PRESALE ORDERS FOR PLANTS TO BE DISTRIBUTED AT THE NIGHT MEETING IN APRIL.

Plants will be small liner seedlings. They come in packs of 72 plants. Each plant will cost \$3.00. The minimum order will be 5 plants for \$15.00.
